## MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

*Men from Jails, Prisons, Streets, Churches*

- Minimum 18 years of age
- Complete and return a signed Application
- Non Sex Offenders
- Minimum of a 4-month commitment required
- Minimum of 16-week lock-in (can be court ordered up to 9-month lock-in)
- Men who want to grow spiritually
- Must be able to work without assistance
- Men with a humble and teachable spirit

Each guest must obtain a shelter clearance

## CHECK IN TIMES

### **Monday- Saturday**

1:00 p.m. - 4:00 p.m.

guests who stay on property until check-in time must check-in before other guests.

### **Sundays**

The check-in time will be 1:00 p.m. till 4:00 p.m.

These times are subject to change for a planned event or inclement weather.

**Unless pre-arranged with a director no one is accepted past 4:00 p.m.**

## WORKING GUESTS

We reserve beds for guests working later than check-in only if the following requirement is met:

A guest who works past check-in time must sign the GCRM work list the morning of and must have a GCRM work slip filled out by their employer upon check-in. GCRM reserves the right to verify all work slips with an employer. **If the guest on the work list learns he isn't coming in that night, he must call GCRM**

**by 4:00 p.m. at (706) 724-6960 opt.1, and speak to a director to have their name taken off the Bed reservation list.**

If GCRM is not made aware that the guest is not returning that night, the following will be applied:

1<sup>st</sup> offense - 3-day suspension

2<sup>nd</sup> offence – 7-day suspension

## AMOUNT OF DAYS

We have a 90-day marker for men who do not have full-time jobs. If a man who does not get social security or disability, has not found employment or entered our addiction program within the first 90 days, he will be suspended for seven days then counseled and offered a 30-day extension. Guests with employment or are active in our program can stay if they are productively working to move on, (They must produce evidence that they are actively making efforts to move, through monthly status reports).

## CHURCH DAYS

Wednesday and Sunday afternoons, all guests are required to attend Victory Baptist Church. Sunday mornings at Victory are optional, but the attendance of a church service is still mandatory.

## RULES

- Attendance at chapel services, church services, and classes are required – (no sleeping)
- No eating or drinking **except** in the dining area. No food is to be brought into the mission by guests
- Guests cannot leave the property unexcused after check-in. **(this will result in a 3-day suspension).**
- Weapons, to include knives are not permitted
- Pornography in any form, in possession, or viewed by a guest will be grounds for suspension.
- Fighting may result in permanent suspension.
- No personal items are allowed in the dorm except a Bible and phone. Personal belongings not secure in the tote room must leave with guests each morning.

- Periodically while offering services, ministries may take pictures for their ministry use, and GCRM may take pictures to promote the GCRM.

## BAGS

a guest who does not return, immediately, his belongings will be removed from the tote room. All Bags left unclaimed after **three days** will be donated into mission property or thrown out.

All personal belongings must fit into our large totes with the lid on properly.

After putting your bags up, you cannot have access to your luggage until the posted times.

Directors reserve the right to check bags before storage or at any time while they are in the tote room.

## SERVICE AND FEES

For men receiving Social Security/Disability or men with at least a 30hr/week full-time job, we ask for a \$25.00/week accountability fee.

We offer a **free 90-day** Residential program in exchange for an hour of actively participating in our work detail after morning bible study, daily.

Personal Laundry – is only done for staff and those enrolled in our 9-month program.
